Thomistic Account of Virtues, Vices, Passions, Gifts of the Holy Spirit

- Theological Virtues: Faith, Hope, Charity
- Cardinal Virtues: Justice, Temperance, Courage, Prudence (also called Practical Wisdom)
- Intellectual Virtues: Wisdom, Understanding, Science, Art, Prudence
- Supernatural (infused) Virtues: Faith, Hope, Charity, Justice, Temperance, Courage, Prudence
- Natural Virtues (acquired by achieving a disposition to act that is "second nature")
- Gifts: Understanding, Knowledge, Wisdom, Counsel, Fortitude, Piety, Fear of the Lord

Cognitive faculties: Faith

- speculative intellect: <u>Wisdom</u>, <u>Understanding</u>, <u>Science</u>

deeper insight into divine truths
proper judgment concerning truths of faith
judgment according to divine norms

- practical intellect:

Knowledge
Wisdom
Prudence, Art

decisions regarding human actions Counsel

Appetitive powers: Hope and Charity

- rational appetite (the will): <u>Justice</u> in relation to others <u>Piety</u>

- sensitive appetites (the passions): <u>Courage</u> and <u>Temperance</u>

proper use of the irascible passions Fortitude

proper use of the pleasure passions Fear of the Lord

Some difficult good that is imagined as:

Despair unobtainable obtainable Hope

Faith. Related vices: infidelity, heresy, apostasy, blasphemy

Hope. Related vices: despair, presumption

Charity. Related vices: hatred, acedia, jealousy, discord, contention, schism, scandal Prudence. Allied virtues: memory, intelligence, docility. Vices: imprudence, negligence

Courage. Related vices: <u>by excess</u>: presumption, ambition, vainglory, <u>by defect</u>: pusillanimity Justice. Allied virtues: religion, obedience, gratitude, truthfulness, friendship, liberality, mercy...

Related vices: avarice, prodigality, flattery, mendacity, irreligion, contempt,...

Temperance: Allied virtues: honesty, abstinence, sobriety, chastity, luxuriousness, continence....
Related vices: incontinence, frigidity/indifference, sensuality, lust...
